Conditions of Entry

1. Open to all people aged between 8 and 30 years inclusive (maximum age being competitors in the year they turn or have turned 30.) Who have a genuine interest in improving their knowledge and skills in the prime lamb industry.
2. Entry fee must accompany entry form or will not be accepted. Late fee will apply.
3. All sheep are to be from a registered APDA stud.
4. All sheep MUST have an NLIS tag.
5. Personal name tags must be worn at all times during the show except for the official dinner.
6. No stud advertising will be allowed to be displayed near the sheep with the exception of participant who are exhibiting their own sheep or who have sponsored the show.
7. Classes for competitors will be determined after entries close.
8. Appropriate clothing must be worn while working with the sheep. . ie. No thongs or sneakers, Boots please
9. All competitors enter at their own risk. Insurance and public liability is the responsibility of the competitor.
10. No alcohol to be consumed by persons under 18 at any time. No alcohol to be consumed outside designated areas, i.e.: at the dinner, for those over 18.
11. Participants exhibiting their own sheep must supply their own equipment and feed.
12. No dogs to be allowed on the grounds.
13. Bedding for the sheep will be supplied.
14. Health status of all exhibits must conform to the district vet officer's requirements and documents of full status must be available on demand. All must be free of Brucellosis, foot rot and from Johnes free flocks.
15. All school aged competitors must be accompanied by a teacher or parent or guardian.
17. Participants ages as at the first day of the show being the 7th August 2010.
16. Disruptive and unacceptable behaviour from exhibitors will not be tolerated. Unacceptable behaviour may lead to disqualification from the competition. Parents will be contacted.
18. The Herdsman competition will be judged over the 2 days of the show.
19. Jumpers will be given to each competitor & is to be worn for the sheep judging and the official photo on Sunday the 8th of August.
20. Competitors are not to leave the Showground without parental supervision or prior Committee consent until the conclusion of the APDJM.
21. There will be NO SMOKING in the sheep sheds, toilets and eating areas. A designated area will be provided.
